

Taco Tuesdays at Rosa's



VBS Work Day



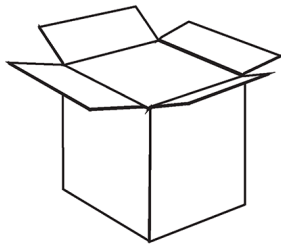
